Nut Free School

Although we recognise that this cannot be guaranteed, Lanivet aims to be a Nut-Free school. This policy serves to set out all measures to reduce the risk to those children and adults who may suffer an anaphylactic reaction if exposed to nuts to which they are sensitive. The school aims to protect children who have allergies to nuts yet also help them, as they grow up, to take responsibility as to what foods they can eat and to be aware of where they may be put at risk. We do not allow nuts or nut products in school lunch boxes. Our "Nut-Free Policy" means that the following items should not be brought into school: • Packs of nuts • Peanut butter sandwiches • Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts • Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts • Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame) • Cakes made with nuts

Sickness Policy reminder

We have had several children off school with a stomach bug this week. Diarrhoea and vomiting can spread easily. If your child has a stomach bug, it could be infectious to others. Your child is most infectious from when the symptoms start until 48 hours after they've passed. If your child has been ill please keep them home for 48 hours from the last episode of sickness. Thank you.
