Another week of fun at Lanivet School has flown past...

This week our **Reception Class** practised hard and performed their harvest songs. The class have started learning letter sounds and how to write them. There has also been lots of free play with friends, making playdough, mud kitchen play and going to the woods.

Class 1 have had a great week practicing their harvest songs too, they have also enjoyed PE with Plymouth Argyle, practiced lots of phonics and enjoyed their Amazing Animals topic. In Science, Class 1 have been looking at animal classifications and had lots of discussion about pets. Everyone really enjoyed looking at all the great pet photos that were sent in, thank you!

Class 2 have had another incredibly busy week with partitioning in Maths, drawing story maps in English and lots of PE. The best bit for them was Geography, some of their learning involved iced water and blue food colouring! This taught them lots about oceans, their size and temperature.

Class 3 have had a fabulous Art lesson, using watercolour paints to create a backwash with silhouette dinosaurs. They have learnt how tectonic plates cause earthquakes and practised how they would protect themselves under the table if an earthquake was happening! They have even been planning their own volcano adventure stories with fantastic, exciting ideas from everyone.

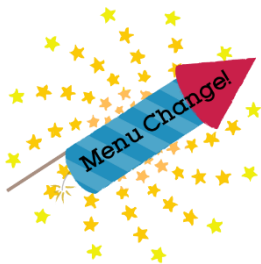
Class 4 have enjoyed their new English unit. They have watched a film clip of a fictional tomb raider- Tadeo Jones and used that to learning about using their senses and personification. They have created some tricky quizzes about Egyptian pharaohs. They had great fun in science investigating which materials would make the best sound proofing for earmuffs!

Class 5 have been looking at the use of metaphors and repetition in poetry. In History, they learnt about King Alfred (famous for burning cakes amongst other things!) and life as an Anglo-Saxon during the Viking Age.

Class 6 have been exploring the use of D.A.S.H (Description, Action, Speech, How is your character feeling?) to help with setting descriptions in English. In Geography, they have been designing informative leaflets about Antarctica and in Science they have continued their work on Carl Linnaeus, looking at microorganisms and mould!
