## Our week at Lanivet...

**Dolphin Class** has had the most amazing week of arts and crafts, singing, storytelling and sports in preparation for their end of year show. The children did an awesome job of performing for the first time to both Year 6 and their families. There were a lot of cool moves, beautiful singing and speedy races. All finished off with a chance for the children to share their writing books and eat biscuits with mums and dads. Wild Warriors ran a fantastic trip to the beach where the children played games, climbed rocks, make sand creations, lit fires and rock pooled.

**Fox Class** have been re-visiting Maths topics and completing assessments. In English, they have been focusing on improving their writing stamina. They have been making their own artwork based on the work of artist, Andy Goldsworthy. They also had a special long music session with Mr Warwick, which the children thoroughly enjoyed.

**Duck Class** have had another super busy week. In English, they finished writing their innovated stories, and invented a new one. In Maths, they have learnt how to find  $\frac{3}{4}$  and  $\frac{2}{3}$  of a quantity. In Geography, they have continued to learn about maps and have used riddles to find continents and oceans in an atlas. They looked at ariel view photographs, whilst spotting the human and physical features of a landscape. They also went on an incredible trip to the beach, where they completed a beach clean, cooked hot dogs, ate s'mores and made some wonderful memories to last a life time - the children were extremely well behaved and did the school proud!

**Otter Class** have been on a school trip to Truro Museum to take part in a Stone Age to Iron Age workshop. They really enjoyed learning about the clay pots and how the design had changed over time. The children made their own coil pot and created a pattern to go on it. It was fascinating to see and touch artifacts such as flint, hand hammers, combs, mirrors and weapons from the Stone Age and Iron Age. The children showed exemplary behaviour, great curiosity and were a real credit to the school. Otters held their fundraising day to adopt endangered animals today. They have raised a fantastic amount of money! They worked very hard in the hot sun to complete their sponsored active afternoon. What a week for **Puffin Class**!! They have written amazing independent instructions for catching a mythical creature. In Maths, they have completed their decimals work and have enjoyed some Kahoot quizzes for their History and Geography topic work. On Tuesday they enjoyed a spectacular mini sports afternoon. Everyone showed incredible sportsmanship and determination. Thursday saw them head to Baby Bay for an adventure with Wild Warriors. They completed beach art, lit fires to cook their lunch, whittled sticks for marshmallows to make s'mores, clambered over the rocks and found some incredible creatures in the rock pools. The class have really enjoyed sharing their many memories with each other and some of the teachers, sometimes reminding each other of things long forgotten. They were transported back to their younger days when they took part in a nursery rhyme-based quiz in music. Parents can wait in the playground, but we are asking that masks are worn whilst on school premises. Teachers will be outside their classrooms to collect children and see them into the building. We ask that parents do not enter classrooms. Once children have been collected by their teachers, parents should leave the playground promptly and we can ensure the playground is secured. Gates will reopen at 14:55 for collection.

## Holiday Clubs

Unfortunately, due to lack of available staff, we are unable to run a Summer Holiday club at Lanivet School this year. Please consider the Time to Move Holiday Programme as an alternative. The T2M Holiday Programme is a Government funded Holiday Activities and Food Programme which will cover the whole of England in 2021. Through this programme, local authorities will provide children aged 5 to 16 free holiday club provision, including healthy food and enriching activities, to children eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals over the Easter, Summer and Christmas holidays in 2021. This programme will be delivered by Active Cornwall and partners to ensure all children in Cornwall eligible for Free Schools Meals will be offered activity during the 3 main school holidays. You can now search and book to attend your local session using the finder below and for those children eligible for benefit related Free School Meals all the provision is FREE for you. You just need to enter your unique access code which was sent home to you in the letter last week.
